NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 3rd day of March, 2022 the Sheffield City Council made the above Orders which come into operation on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2022 under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Orders will be to introduce:

- Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time on parts of Angel Street and Broadfield Road – left turn slip lane;
- No loading at any time on parts of Angel Street and London Road;
- Taxi Rank on parts of Angel Street;
- Prohibited right hand turn on part of Broadfield Road left turn slip lane;

And remove:

- Taxi Rank on part of Angel Street;
- Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time on part of Angel Street;
- No loading/unloading 7.30am to 6.30pm on parts of Broadfield Road, London Road and Saxon Road; and
- No loading 8am to 6.30pm on part of Angel Street.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Orders or any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the enabling Act or that a requirement of the enabling Act or any of the relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the 7<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 make application for that purpose to the High Court.

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 46A, 49, 51, 53 and 124 (1) (c) (d) and (f) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c.27) ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 7th day of March, 2022 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Broadfield Road and Glover Road) (Prohibition of Driving and Prohibited Turns) Order 2022.

Prohibited/Prescribed Turns

2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in a north easterly direction on the Broadfield Road left turn slip lane on reaching the junction with London Road to make a right turn in to that road.

The Sheffield City Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) under Sections 1, 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 46A, 49, 51, 53 and 124(1)(c), (d) and (f) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c.27) (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part 111 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Sheffield City Council (Consolidation) (On-Street Parking and Prohibition of Waiting) (City Centre Controlled Parking Zone) Order 2008 (as amended) shall have effect as though:-

a) In Schedule 10 thereto for the items ‘Angel Street – (i) and (ii)’ there was substituted the following:-

(ii) The south west side from a point 29 metres north west of its junction with the north western kerb line of High Street for a distance of 19 metres in a north westerly direction.	All hours	

b) In Schedule 1.01 thereto there was deleted the item ‘4 Angel Street – both sides’.

c) In Schedule 4.01 thereto there was deleted the item ‘1 Angel Street – both sides’.

d) In Schedule 1.01 thereto there were included the following items:-

- (i) From its junction with the southern kerb line of Wolseley Road to a point 62 metres south of its junction with the southern kerb line of Wolseley Road.

c) In Schedule 4.27 thereto there were deleted the items 'Broadfield Road' and 'Saxon Road'.

d) In Schedule 1.011 thereto there was included the following item:-
