So that you can enjoy learning, socialising and performing in a safe environment, it is important that everyone who is part of our group understands and observes our Code of Conduct. These are some simple rules that help make sure the experience of performing is safe and enjoyable for everyone.

Please make sure that you always observe the following, whether you are here with us or when you are using social media:

- Be friendly ~ always welcome new performers
- Be a loyal team member, take care of your co-performers, look out for them and listen
- Do your best to keep yourself and others safe. Do not do something if you do not feel safe
- If you are worried about something, let your chaperone or other trusted adult know
- Respect other children and young people, as well as chaperones, officials and other leaders
- Be mindful of how you speak to people; do not use strong or offensive language
- Never be violent or aggressive in what you say or do
- Take care of the environment you are in; the equipment and facilities and shared spaces
- Treat people equally and respect everyone regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity
- Refrain from bullying and do not push others into doing things
- Refrain from sharing information or images about people inappropriately
- Keep to agreed timings
- Be polite at all times
